# Why are preventive care and regular check-ups important?

Many illnesses do not show signs or make people feel sick until there is already damage done.

For instance, heart disease is the leading cause of death in the U.S. The two most important causes of heart disease are high blood pressure and high cholesterol. But most people can't tell they have it because they have no noticeable symptoms. The same is true for diabetes. One in four people with diabetes does not know they have it.

# How often should you have a check up?

It is important to see a health care provider at least once a year for a complete physical. Persons with health problems like high blood pressure or diabetes should be seen more often.

# Are there other ways to stay healthy?

Yes! Many health problems can be managed by changing your habits. Knowledge about your health is a powerful weapon for improving it. Your health care provider can give you information and support to make healthy changes.


