Mr. Nefzger reviewed the monthly balances for December 2017 in the general, schoolhouse, student activity and food service funds. President Coil reported that the report would be filed subject to audit.

<u>Item No. 5 – Approval of Change Orders for Aldrich Elementary</u>

Mr. Nefzger updated the Board on the construction of Aldrich Elementary and the change order request. At the time of project approval Alternate #2 was included for a second reinjection well, although it was thought it may not be needed. After the completion of the installation and testing of the main well it was determined the second reinjection well for the geothermal system is not needed and it is the recommendation of the design team to eliminate Alternate #2. Director Orvis moved and Director Hines seconded the motion that the Cedar Falls Community School District approve the construction change order for a credit of \$175,000.00 to delete Alternate #2 (additional reinjection well) for Aldrich Elementary School. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Coil, Giddens, Hines, Leeper, Orvis and Wohlpart. Those voting "no" none. Motion carried.

<u>Item No. 6 – Approval of Change Orders for Orchard Hill Elementary</u>

Mr. Nefzger updated the Board on the construction of Orchard Hill Elementary and the change order requests. There are four change order requests that include reducing the size of the front entrance canopy, delete window bump outs and other canopies, change some spiral duct to duct sock, and revise the geothermal well piping for a total reduction in cost of \$102,893. Dan Channer of Struxture Architects answered some questions from the Board. Director Wohlpart moved and Director Hines seconded the motion Cedar Falls Community School District approve the construction change order for construction changes to Orchard Hill Elementary for a total reduction in costs of \$102,893. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Coil, Giddens, Hines, Leeper, Orvis and Wohlpart. Those voting "no" none. Motion carried.

<u>Item No. 7 – Approval of 84 Passenger Transit School Bus Bids</u>

Mr. Nefzger reviewed the bids received for the purchase of two 84 passenger transit school buses with air ride suspension and rear backup cameras for the 2018/19 school year. There was two bids received and it is the recommendation of the administration to accept the low bid from School Bus Sales, Waterloo Iowa in the amount \$192,412.00, net after trade-in of two school buses. The purchase of these buses will be funded through the 2018-2019 Physical Plant and Equipment Levy. After discussion, Director Giddens moved and Director Leeper seconded the motion to approve the purchase of two 84 passenger transit school buses with air ride suspension and rear backup from School Bus Sales in Waterloo Iowa at a net cost bid of \$192,412. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Coil, Giddens, Hines, Leeper, Orvis and Wohlpart. Those voting "no" none. Motion carried.
