PEET JR HIGH ONLINE REGISTRATION INFORMATION: The district will hold online registration for all returning students. This will allow you to register your student online via your PowerSchool Parent Portal. **We will not hold a traditional registration.** Online registration will be opened on July 1st.

Returning students may access online registration information from our district website [HERE](#). You will register through your PowerSchool Parent Portal.

Online Registration Assistance will be available July 1 - August 23 from 7:30am – 4:00pm at *Cedar Falls Administration Building - 1002 W 1st Street* (not available at Peet Junior High). Feel free to visit the Administration Center to complete your student's registration if you do not have internet or smart phone access. **Registration fees, activity tickets, PATT donations and other fines will be available to pay via the Tiger Store July 1 at <https://cedar-falls.revtrak.net/>.

Peet will host a **Parent Help Day** on Monday, August 13 from 1:00pm-4:00pm & 5:00pm-7:00pm at Peet Junior High. This will be the only time you will be able to receive assistance with online registration at Peet Junior High's building. You can also receive assistance with paying fees and turn-in all health forms including the physical and concussion forms.

SCHOOL PICTURES: School pictures will be taken on Thursday, August 30 and Friday, August 31 during PE classes. All students, regardless of picture purchase, will be photographed **free** for school records and the memory book. Picture order forms will be distributed to students the first week of school. If ordering, payment for pictures is required at the time of photographing. Make checks payable to LifeTouch. Money back guarantee.

SCHOOL BREAKFAST/LUNCH: Prices for secondary students are: breakfast \$2.35 and lunch \$3.10. Deposits may be made on-line, at Parent Help Day, or at Back to School Night.

PEET PATT: (Parents And Teachers Together) Parents are invited to join PATT and participate in PATT activities. The PATT parent group organizes volunteers for numerous school activities including dances, Adopt-A-Family, etc. They also fundraise for the school, provide food for conferences and celebrations, and help with school donations. A suggested membership donation is \$10.00 per household. BUS ROUTES, PASSES AND TICKETS: Bus routes will be published on the district website prior to the first day of classes. All Peet students who live over **two** miles away from Peet are eligible for a free pass. Students who live less than two miles away and wish to ride the bus will need to purchase monthly tickets; the monthly bus tickets will be available beginning August 28th. Bus prices are as follows: two-way monthly pass - \$50.00 / one-way (AM or PM) monthly pass - \$25.00. **All bus tickets for September must be purchased by September 7.** Thereafter, tickets are to be purchased during the week preceding the first of each month. **Bus riders must show their pass or ticket each day when getting on the bus.** Additionally, the District is offering one-day, one-way bus passes that are sold for \$1.25. These bus passes will be

sold in the main office at Peet starting on August 30th. If your student plans to ride the bus at any time during the 18-19 school year, please fill-out this form requesting transportation: [Bus Request Form](#).

VACCINE REMINDERS FOR 2018-19:

Vaccine Requirements: Reminder for parents of students of 7th and 12th grade students 2018-2019: When scheduling your medical provider visits keep in mind that the Meningococcal Vaccine, specifically A/C/Y/W vaccine, is **REQUIRED** for all incoming students entering 7th and 12th grades for the 2018-2019 school year. Students must have the vaccine prior to the first day of school to attend and will not be permitted to attend until the vaccine is received.

Incoming 7th graders have an additional requirement of a Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine booster. Contact your student's health office if you have questions.

HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITY TICKETS: Junior High students may purchase a High School activity ticket. Tickets may be purchased when paying registration fees on-line. In addition, activity tickets may be purchased in the main office throughout the school year. Cost of the ticket is \$45.00, and it will be good for admission to more than fifty high school athletic, music, and drama activities. Six dollars of each activity ticket purchased by a Peet student will go to the Peet Activity Fund. Make checks payable to Peet Junior High School.
