Personal Safety



SMARTORSCARY?

Smartphones are essentially little computers, so you might be a little worried when handing one over to your child. Take some time to understand the risks and implement a few safeguards so that you can help your child use smartphones safely.

THE RISKS

• CYBERBULLYING With the constant connectivity of smartphones, your child may be more susceptible to cyberbullying or have more opportunities to cyberbully others.

GEOLOCATION
A GPS-enabled smartphone can reveal

your child's location through online posts and uploaded photos.

• INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT With smartphones, your child has mobile access to content you may consider inappropriate, such as pornography or violent videos.

SEXTING Your child may use the Internet and social apps to send, receive, or forward revealing photos.

VIRUSES & MALWARE

Just like a computer, a smartphone is vulnerable to security attacks if your child accesses unsecured websites and apps.

5WAYS TO BE SMARTER THAN THE **SMARTPHONE!**

- 1. Be a parent and a resource. Establish clear guidelines, including time limits and consequences for inappropriate behavior, but be open so your child will come to you with any problems.
- Set up password protection. This will keep everyone but you and your child from accessing personal information stored on the phone.
- 3. Update the operating system. New versions often contain important security fixes.
- Approve apps before they are downloaded. Make sure you understand their capabilities and approve their content.
- Understand location services. GPS features are useful when using maps, but you'll want to disable location-tagging when your child posts anything online.

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HOMEWORK COMPLETION: Please make sure your student(s) are completing their homework. We ask our teachers to only assign homework if it is meaningful and necessary to help students learn what is needed for their course. Because of that, we expect all students to complete their assigned homework on time. Students that need extra time are provided that time when they are genuinely trying.

Students that choose to not do their work are assigned to one hour of detention after school. We do this for a number of reasons:

- Students need to have a full understanding of the material.
- Students need to be prepared for classroom activities.
- The consequence for not doing the work is doing the work.

At Peet Jr. High, academics is the priority. If students have an activity after school, that is not a reason to miss detention. Getting the work done is the priority. Students out for athletics have to serve the hour and then go to practice or game.
