COUNSELING SOUND-BYTE:

INTERNET SAFETY AND YOUR STUDENT

The internet has drastically changed the way that your student interacts with the world. Your student has access to in-depth knowledge, tools and access to people from around the world. Along with this access comes cyber-bullying, access to inappropriate materials, online predators and revealing too much information. As a parent or a guardian, you can be a resource for your student to make the internet a safer tool to use.

Your student may use a variety of social media services and each of these has different safety concerns. Here are some tips that you can use to keep your student safe online regardless of which media they choose.

- *Keep your computer in a high traffic area of your home.
- *Establish limits for the online sites that your student may visit and limit their time on each one.
- *Remember that the internet is mobile and your student has 24/7 access if they have a smart phone. Be sure to check their phones, gaming devices and chromebooks.
- *Surf the internet with your student and let them show you what they like to do while on the internet.
- *Know who is connecting with your student and set up rules for social networking and using the web-cam.
- *Continually dialogue with your student about online safety and continue to learn about these resources yourself.

MAKE A MEAL PAYMENT ONLINE!

The option to make online payments into your Family Meal Account is now live and working! Instructions are below:

Go to: https://cedar-falls.revtrak.net/tek9.asp

- 1. Click on Meal Account Payment to the left under Browse
- 2. Enter the Deposit Amount
- 3. Enter your Student ID number. If you do not know your Student ID number, this can be found on the Powerschool Parent Portal on the Balance Page, next to the student's name: https://powerschool.cfschools.org/public/
- 4. Click "Check Balance" to check your account balance
- 5. Confirm the amount you would like to add and click "Add to Shopping Cart"
- 6. Confirm your payment choices and click "Go to Checkout"
- 7. If you are a new RevTrak customer, select "I am a new customer", enter your billing information and create a password
- 8. If you are a returning customer, select "I am a returning customer", enter your email address and click "Sign in"
- 9. Enter your Payment Information
- 10. Verify information for accuracy and select Complete Order
- 11. A receipt will be emailed to you. Please check your spam filter if you do not receive it.

You are able to view balances in PowerSchool on the Balance Page and locate your Student's ID number: https://powerschool.cfschools.org/public/

You still have the option to send cash or check to Peet or bring in a credit card and make payment at Peet. Balances are updated in PowerSchool once per day at approximately 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Family Meal Account Balance(s) apply to your entire family. When you make a payment for any one of your children/dependents, the funds are available for all of them to use.
