Policy Title: Career Education Code No. 602.9

Preparing students for careers is one goal of the education program. Career education shall be infused into the

education program for grades kindergarten through twelve. This education shall include, but not be limited to,

awareness of self in relation to others and the needs of society, exploration of employment opportunities,

experiences in personal decision-making, and experiences of integrating work values and work skills into their

lives.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent or designee to assist certified personnel in finding ways to

provide career education in most courses. Special attention should be given to courses of vocational education

nature. The board, in its review of the curriculum, shall review the means in which career education is combined

with other instructional programs.
