CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION: On Tuesday, June 5, students will be turning in their Chromebooks for the summer. This will take place during their Tiger Time classes. Students who do not turn in their Chromebooks will <u>not be eligible to participate in the Last Day Activities on June 5th</u>. Please help your child come to school with all necessary equipment on the last day of school. This includes the Chromebook, the case, and the charger. Chromebooks will be inspected and assessed for any obvious and visual damage at this time. If damage is found, parents will be informed via email, and the IT department will add the appropriate repair fees in PowerSchool.

CONDITIONS FOR LEARNING SURVEY:

All students in Iowa grades 5-12 will be required by the state of Iowa to take a survey between April 11 and May 30 that is a part of Iowa's Every Student Succeeds Act plan. The survey will consist of 36 questions that cover safety, school expectations, student relationships with other students, and adult relationships with students and should take about 15 minutes. If you have questions or would like to have your student opt out of taking the survey, please contact Mr. Boevers.

<u>SUMMER PROGRAMS:</u> This summer Peet Junior High will offer Read180 to a select group of students. Our intent is to support reading literacy development in preparation of the 2018 - 2019 school year. It is our hope that students involved with the Read 180 program will lead to improvement in his/her reading comprehension. The intent of the program is for students to continue to make advances with his/her reading and narrow the gap with his/her peers. Read 180 will be offered July 9 - 26 Monday through Thursday (8:00 – 9:30 AM) or (10:00 – 11:30AM). Transportation is available if needed. Information will be sent to a select number of students.

In addition to Summer Read 180 a remedial math class is planned. The **Summer Math 180 program** will be offered July 9 - 26 and will follow the Read 180 schedule. Two sessions will be offered Monday -Thursday. Information will be sent to a select number of students.

BOOST will run August 13 - 16, 2018 Monday through Thursday 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The intent of the BOOST Program is to give students the opportunity to visit and learn about Peet Junior High prior to their arrival for the 2018 - 2019 school year this fall. VACCINE REMINDERS FOR 2018-19:

Vaccine Requirements: Reminder for parents of students of 7th and 12th grade students 2018-2019: When scheduling your medical provider visits keep in mind that the Meningococcal Vaccine, specifically A/C/Y/W vaccine, is REQUIRED for all incoming students entering 7th and 12th grades for the 2018-2019 school year. Students must have the vaccine prior to the first day of school to attend and will not be permitted to attend until the vaccine is received.

Incoming 7th graders have an additional requirement of a Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine booster. Contact your student's health office if you have questions.
