USDA Free Meals for All Students
Ending June 30, 2022

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) universal free meal waiver, provided during the COVID-19 pandemic, is set to expire June 30, 2022. While the federal government funded a program that allowed all students access to free meals during the COVID-19 pandemic, Congress recently declined to continue funding this program. *This means families who do not meet eligibility requirements, will begin paying for meals effective August 2022.*

We understand this change may cause concern. There are steps you can take today to make sure your child continues to receive nutritious meals next year.

Transportation is free for **junior high students** (7-9) that live more than two miles from their resident school. These distances are determined by the Cedar Falls Transportation Department. Parents/Guardians of open enrolled students are responsible for their student(s) transportation. Parents/Guardians of Rules Exception students are responsible for their student(s) transportation.

After eligible students have been added to the routes and space is not a factor on the bus, students who live under the minimum distance may be able to ride as a "Paid Rider". They would have to go to the closest bus stop that goes to their resident school. The bus pass can be purchased at their school and will be presented to the bus driver while loading.
