- 1. Confirm what you owe. The Federal Student Aid website at https://studentaid.gov is the easiest and most efficient way to access this information. Once logged in, you can view the original principal amount, current balance, and interest rate.
- 2. Evaluate your repayment plan. The FSA's website also has a loan simulator. Spendsome time deciding which payment plan fits your goals (lower payments? faster payoffs?) and consider switching to an income-driven repayment plan. This takes your earnings into account and may help lower your monthly payment.
