## **ANONYMOUS ALERTS:**

The District has implemented an important new communications tool called Anonymous Alerts. Anonymous Alerts allows students, parents and staff to quickly, easily, and anonymously report urgent information to school officials across all of our school buildings. The system encourages students, parents and staff to confidentially report sensitive topics through private messages to the District.

To submit an alert on your phone:

- Download the Anonymous Alerts® app for free from the Apple Store, Google Play store, or the Chrome store
- Start the App, enter **activation code: cedarfallscsd**
- Send important reports to school officials

The mobile apps and web-based reporting system provides secure 1-way or 2-way encrypted messages, increasing the flow of important information to school officials. Message topics for submission may include bullying, cyber-bullying, family difficulties, drug and alcohol abuse, sexual harassment, vaping, anti-LGBTQ+ motivated incident/discrimination or racially motivated incident/discrimination.

All reports remain completely anonymous, although submitters have the option to reveal their identity if they prefer to have a person-to-person discussion. The program is monitored from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m., and should only be used for serious and urgent matters.

We feel that we have a responsibility to offer this tool to our community in order to protect the safety of our students, providing avenues for confidential disclosure when there is something serious that is troubling them.

## **MASKS:**

Overall, our students have done remarkably well when it comes to wearing masks and following all guidelines that have been put in place. We have noticed a few students that want to pull their mask down so the nose is exposed. It is important that students wear the mask as it is designed to mitigate risk to themselves and to others. If there are students that continue to need reminders, we will meet with these students and follow up appropriately as needed including a parent contact. Please talk to your students about the importance of wearing a mask and making sure that the nose is covered at all times. We want to keep everybody safe. Please also remind your student to bring a mask each day and keep an extra in their backpack as we have gone through many disposable masks each day for students who have either forgotten their mask or their mask has broken. All students who will be participating in athletics and cheerleading must have a physical examination BEFORE they may practice. Sports physicals signed on or after July 1, 2019 are valid through December 2020. Sports physicals may be dropped off to the Peet office.

**CONDUCT OF CODE FORM:** *New this year – [Online Form!](#)*

If your student believes they will be participating in athletics or cheerleading at Peet Junior High for the 2020-21 school year, a Code of Conduct/Concussion Heads Up Form will need to be turned-in. We have made this process much easier by creating an online form for the parent and student to fill-out together. Parents and Athletes must fill-out this [Code of Conduct / Concussion Heads Up Form](#) together before the student begins practicing. A new code of conduct must be turned in at the beginning of each year, there is no grace period for these forms like the sports physical. \*\*If families prefer, a hard copy of the Code of Conduct can also be signed and turned into the office.

If you have already turned in a new sports physical or completed the code of conduct for a Fall sport, there is no need to turn in another.
