CHROMEBOOK INFORMATION

Welcome back to another great school year. The following are tips and tricks suggested for students to utilize their chromebooks in a safe and appropriate manner during the 2024-2025 school year.

- Charge the chromebook at home each night. The chromebook battery is meant to last an entire school day.
- Do your best to leave chargers at home or in backpacks if they come to school to avoid them getting lost or stolen.
- Don't eat or drink near the chromebook to avoid accidental damage.
- Use the case provided to help keep the chromebook safe from damage during transport.
- Remind your child NEVER to provide a last name or a location when entering personal information into a website or app.
- Talk to your child about online bullying and the importance of reporting it to an adult.
- If your child is worried about the online behaviors of a friend or peer, they should talk to an adult either at home or school.
- Remind your child that the school owns the Chromebook. Everything they do on this Chromebook is traced to their school account and becomes part of their "digital footprint". This includes using the school devices to play games that are not school approved or signing up for non educational websites with their school email.

For the 2024-2025 school year, fees for first time damages to student devices will be waived. Any subsequent device damages by students after their one time waiver has been used will be assessed at the current cost of replacement parts or devices to the district. In some cases excessive damages necessitating a complete replacement of the device, intentional damage and lost devices may not be covered by the one time waiver.

Current replacement part fees are listed in the chart below. Total replacement cost for the Dell 3100 & 3110 Series Chromebook for the upcoming school year will be \$245 based on the district's cost.

All technology repair fees will be entered into PowerSchool by district technology staff once assessments and repairs have been made. If you have questions about technology fees you may email cftechfees@cfschools.org for more information.

ACTIVITY BUS

Students who travel to Holmes or CFHS for after school activities /athletics will ride bus #20, activity bus. This bus will leave immediately after school.

BOUND

All 7-12 grade athletes will be required to sign-up for their activities using the Bound program. Register your student-athlete online then click on registration.

Bound is a web platform used by all high schools and most junior high schools in Iowa to house team schedules, state required stats, event locations, event tickets (and passes), and much more. Cedar Falls will be using many more Bound features starting this school year.

At Peet, we put an emphasis on academics with our students. We will be assigning students 30 minutes Alternative Learning Time after school if they have not completed assigned work. Students would be expected to stay in the classroom of the assigning teacher from 3:00 - 3:30 to get help from the teacher to complete the work. If that teacher is not available after school, we will assign them to another room with another teacher.

Teachers will notify parents if their student is assigned. Parents will be responsible to pick the student up at 3:30, or the students can stay for ECHOES which runs until 4:30 Tuesday - Thursday. A bus is provided for students that choose to stay for ECHOES.

If a student is involved in athletics, they will be sent to practice at 3:30.

Our intention is to teach students responsibility and the importance of completing assigned tasks on time, as well as helping them learn what they need to be successful. In the past, parents have been very supportive of this intervention to help their students. If you have any questions regarding Alternative Learning Time, please call the school and ask for Mr. Meister.

Key Points from:
[Keep Your Child On Track in Middle and High School: Pay Attention to Attendance](#)

Even as children grow older and more independent, families play a key role in making sure students access learning opportunities and understand why attendance is so important for success in school and on the job.

- Did you know?**
- Students should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful and on track to graduation
 - By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school
 - By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores

- What You Can Do**
- Talk about the importance of showing up to school every day
 - Try not to schedule dental and medical appointments during the school day
 - Help your teen stay engaged by encouraging them to join meaningful after-school activities, including sports and clubs
 - Check on your child's attendance to be sure absences are not adding up
 - Seek help from school staff, other parents or community agencies if you need support
