Before Testing

- CHARGE YOUR CHROMEBOOK! Bring your Chromebook charger with you on testing days.
- Get a good night's sleep! Try to get at least 8 hours. If you can get more, that is awesome!
- Eat breakfast. Breakfast is served in the Cafeteria every morning starting at 7:25 AM. (Energy drinks are NOT breakfast!) Eat some real food!
- Make sure you are NOT connected to the TIGER WIFI Network. You
 MUST be connected to the CFCSD Network. If you need help
 getting connected to the correct network, stop in the Media
 Center prior to testing.
- If you're unsure of the schedule for the day or where you are supposed to go, ask an adult in the building. We will help you!

Student Honor Code

Expectations for student behavior during and after testing. Prohibited behaviors include but are not limited to:

- Using personal electronics to capture test items or responses
- NO airpods or wireless headphones must use wired headphones
- Providing assistance to or accepting assistance from other students
- Discussing test items or responses with students who have not yet tested
- Sharing test tickets, or retaining tickets or scratch paper after testing

During Testing:

- Cell phones and smartwatches are not allowed . Please leave them in your locker or you will store them in a designated area in your Tiger Time classroom. You will not have access to them during testing.
- No airpods or wireless headphones must use wired headphones
- Take a stretch break in between tests!
- Identify when you're stressing and take some time to re-group.
 - Stop what you're doing
 - Take 3 deep breaths
 - Skip the question you're on and come back to it later, if necessary.

During Testing (cont):

- Some/many students will also have line reader, answer masking, color contrasting and text-to-speech
 - You will be provided with headphones if text-to-speech is available to you
 - PLEASE use these features if they are helpful to you!!!
- You may use scratch paper. Please put your name on all scratch paper as it will be picked up and handed in after testing.
- The calculator for the math test is built into the testing program.
- Remember the testing tools (bookmark, answer eliminator, etc) available to you during testing.

You are **READY**!

- Remember, you are prepared and ready for these tests!
- You spent time last week learning about the test format, test tools and doing numerous practice tests.
- You've also been preparing for these tests all year long in your classes. Try your best and don't give up!
- Bookmark and move on from a question if you're not sure. Come back to the unanswered questions before you submit.
- Why we test? We use the ISASP test results as one data point for class placements (Enhancement, Honors, AP) and to assess your learning from year-to-year.
