SCHOOL LUNCHES

USDA Free Meals for All Students Ending June 30, 2022

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) universal free meal waiver, provided during the COVID-19 pandemic, is set to expire June 30, 2022. While the federal government funded a program that allowed all students access to free meals during the COVID-19 pandemic, Congress recently declined to continue funding this program. This means families who do not meet eligibility requirements, will begin paying for meals effective August 2022.

We understand this change may cause concern. There are steps you can take today to make sure your child continues to receive nutritious meals next year.

Complete the 2021-22 Free and Reduced Application NOW - for those children that are determined eligible based on the 2021-2022 Free and Reduced Application, a 30-day grace period is provided at the start of the 2022-2023 school year.

After July 1, 2022, complete the 2022-2023 Free and Reduced Application on the District's website.
