e. Wellness – Jodie Huegerich (5 min)

i. Wellness Update Looking for a co-chair to take over next year. Responsibilities include maintaining gardens, wellness activities, kale chips, maintaining wellness website, and other duties as needed.

f. Fundraising – Cole Bowermaster (15 min) Taking an approach to try and avoid selling things to raise money. We held the first read-a-thoin last year. 47% participation last year, goal is closer to 75% participation this year. We will use a wish list of items for the school to help advertise and encourage participation.
