- Teacher learning
 - Teachers looked at what we want all students to learn and how we can strengthen our instruction and assessment.
- Doing some additional testing to see where reading gaps are
 - Phonic and phonemic awareness
 - Book study and new materials to provide some intervention and support
- SABERS
 - A new assessment looking at behavior
 - K-6 teachers do an inventory on students
 - 3-6 grade students do a self-assessment on their behavior
 - Trying to identify students who need additional supports in place at school
 - A question was asked about why students no longer have morning recess
 - Initially, this was stopped due to COVID
 - This year, we decided to not have morning recess because our days start smoother. Also, supervision was difficult during this time.
 - Some parents and students are saying that they don't want to get to school on time. Has this impacted tardies? Has this impacted students' social interactions?
 - Mr. Ortman didn't have statistics on the exact numbers, but commented that there does not seem to be an increase in tardies this year.
- A question was also asked about recess time shrinking.
 - No, we are not actively looking to add extra recess time. As students grow older, their required recess times are reduced. We also have requirements from the state and district regarding instructional minutes. Supervision also plays a part in this.
