**CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION:** On Thursday, June 6, students will be turning in their Chromebooks for the summer. This will take place during their Tiger Time classes. **END OF SEMESTER 2:** The End of Semester 2 is Thursday, June 6. You will be able to view Semester 2 grades on Monday, June 10th on PowerSchool. Grade reports will not be mailed home, you will receive an email with your students final grade report for the 2018-19 school year.

**SUMMER PROGRAMS:** This summer Peet Junior High will offer **Read180** to a select group of students. Our intent is to support reading literacy development in preparation of the 2019 - 2020 school year. It is our hope that students involved with the Read 180 program will lead to improvement in his/her reading comprehension. The intent of the program is for students to continue to make advances with his/her reading and narrow the gap with his/her peers. Read 180 will be offered July 8 - 25 Monday through Thursday (8:00 – 9:30 AM) or (10:00 – 11:30AM). Information will be sent to a select number of students.

In addition to Summer Read 180 a remedial math class is planned. The Summer Math 180 program will be offered July 8-25 and will follow the Read 180 schedule. Two sessions will be offered Monday -Thursday. Information will be sent to a select number of students.

BOOST will run August 12 - 15, 2019 Monday through Thursday 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The intent of the BOOST Program is to give students the opportunity to visit and learn about Peet Junior High prior to their arrival for the 2019 - 2020 school year this fall. #### VACCINE REMINDERS FOR 2019-20:

Vaccine Requirements: Reminder for parents of students of 7th and 12th grade students 2018-2019: When scheduling your medical provider visits keep in mind that the Meningococcal Vaccine, specifically A/C/Y/W vaccine, is **REQUIRED** for all incoming students entering 7th and 12th grades for the 2019-2020 school year. Students must have the vaccine prior to the first day of school to attend and will not be permitted to attend until the vaccine is received.

Incoming 7th graders have an additional requirement of a Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine booster. Contact your student's health office if you have questions.

#### IDEA Part B – Parent Survey:

Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) requires states to report the percent of parents with a child receiving special education services who report that schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results for children with IEPs.
