AGREEMENT BETWEEN

HUDSON COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE

CEDAR FALLS COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Board of Education of the Cedar Falls Community School District and the Board of Education of the Hudson Community School District agree to permit the enrollment of, Thomas Paulsen, a student who is a resident of the Cedar Falls Community School District, as provided by Iowa Code 256.13:

256.13 Nonresident pupils

The boards of directors of two or more school districts may by agreement provide for attendance of pupils residing in one district in the schools of another district for the purpose of taking courses not offered in the district of their resident. ... Courses and grades made available to students in this manner shall be considered as complying with any standards or laws requiring the offering of such courses and grades. The boards of directors of districts entering into such agreements may provide for sharing the costs and expenses of the courses.

This agreement is in effect for the 2020-2021 school year unless revoked in writing by either Board. A condition of continuation for any specific school year would be that space is available in the school.

This agreement must be discontinued at any such time the superintendent or principal of Hudson High School deems necessary.
