ACTIVITY BUS

Students who travel to Holmes or CFHS for after school activities /athletics will ride bus #20, activity bus. This bus will leave immediately after school.

BOUND

All 7-12 grade athletes will be required to sign-up for their activities using the Bound program. Register your student-athlete online then click on registration.

Bound is a web platform used by all high schools and most junior high schools in Iowa to house team schedules, state required stats, event locations, event tickets (and passes), and much more. Cedar Falls will be using many more Bound features starting this school year.

Back-to-Back days: January 16 & 21 - B Days

If there is a snow day, we will make up the day we missed the following day. Example: If there is a snow day on Monday, December 2, a scheduled B day, when we return to school on Tuesday, December 3, that will be a B day.

If there is a weather related delay, we will run a Monday school day schedule, with classes starting at 9:30am (90-minutes late).

The first semester ends on Thursday, January 16. Please talk to your children and ask how they are doing with their classes. Parents can also check student progress on PowerSchool, or have students pull up PowerSchool to check their grades.

If there is work to be done, you can help by providing them a quiet place to work, preferably at a table or counter for a period of time. Removing distractions, like cell phones, and turning off TV or music will help the students work more efficiently. If you are able, take some time to sit with the kids to provide help or support. Even if the kids are working on subject matter that you are not familiar with, sometimes it is helpful for students to just have somebody sit with them and talk through the work they are doing. Having an adult or older sibling can make a difference.

While we are close to the end of the semester, there is still a lot of time to catch up on what has not been learned.

Key Points from:

Keep Your Child On Track in Middle and High School: Pay Attention to Attendance

Even as children grow older and more independent, families play a key role in making sure students access learning opportunities and understand why attendance is so important for success in school and on the job.

Did you know?

- Students should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful and on track to graduation
- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school
- By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores

What You Can Do

- Talk about the importance of showing up to school every day
- Try not to schedule dental and medical appointments during the school day
- Help your teen stay engaged by encouraging them to join meaningful after-school activities, including sports and clubs
- Check on your child's attendance to be sure absences are not adding up
- Seek help from school staff, other parents or community agencies if you need support
