By May 2024, 85% of the 3rd-11th grade students will be proficient or advanced proficient in **ELA** as measured by the Iowa State-wide Assessment of Student Progress.

By May 2024, 83.5% of the 3rd -11th grade students will be proficient or advanced proficient in Math as measured by the Iowa State-wide Assessment of Student Progress.



### **DISTRICT ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT 23-24**

#### **English Language Arts:**

By May 2024, 85% of 3rd - 11th grade students will be proficient or advanced proficient as measured by the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP)

#### **Goal Status:**

Achieved: 83.4% of students were Proficient or Advanced.


The goal for ELA was not fully met, with 83.4% of students achieving Proficient or Advanced, slightly below the 85% target.



#### **Mathematics:**

By May 2024, 83.5% of 3rd - 11th grade students will be proficient or advanced proficient as measured by the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP)

#### **Goal Status:**

Achieved: 81.8% of students were Proficient or Advanced.

The goal for Mathematics was also not fully met, with 81.8% of students achieving Proficient or Advanced, below the 83.5% target.







#### Mean Score Composite








