## LAST DAY OF SCHOOL:

**CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION:** On Thursday, June 6, students will be turning in their Chromebooks for the summer. This will take place during their Tiger Time classes. Students who do not turn in their Chromebooks will not be eligible to participate in the Last Day Activities on June 6th. Please help your child come to school with all necessary equipment on the last day of school. This includes the Chromebook, the case, and the charger. Any visible damage to the Chromebooks will be noted at this time.

9<sup>th</sup> grade parents: All 9<sup>th</sup> grade Chromebooks will be inspected and assessed by the district's IT department. If there is excessive damage or missing items (e.g., broken screen, no charger, etc.), parents will be informed via email, and the IT department will add the appropriate repair or replacement fees in PowerSchool.

**END OF SEMESTER 2:** The End of Semester 2 is Thursday, June 6. You will be able to view Semester 2 grades on Monday, June 10th on PowerSchool. Grade reports will be mailed home along with honor roll certificates; you will also receive an email with your student's final grade report for the 2018-19 school year.

### **VACCINE REMINDERS FOR 2019-20:**

Vaccine Requirements: Reminder for parents of students of 7th and 12th grade students 2018-2019: When scheduling your medical provider visits keep in mind that the Meningococcal Vaccine, specifically A/C/Y/W vaccine, is **REQUIRED** for all incoming students entering 7th and 12th grades for the 2019-2020 school year. Students must have the vaccine prior to the first day of school to attend and will not be permitted to attend until the vaccine is received.

Incoming 7th graders have an additional requirement of a Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine booster. Contact your student's health office if you have questions.

### **SUMMER OFFICE HOURS:**

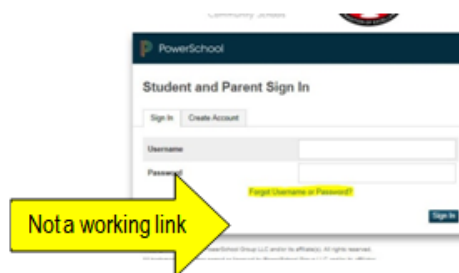

**PEET JR HIGH ONLINE REGISTRATION INFORMATION:** The district will hold online registration for all returning students. This will allow you to register your student online via your PowerSchool Parent Portal. **We will not hold a traditional registration.** Online registration will be opened on July 8<sup>th</sup> (date subject to change).
