- II. UNI Physical Education Students -Adam VanErsvelde, Morgan Kappel, Tyus Grant
 - quality physical education: physical activity (body movement with energy expenditure), recess (break from structured expectations), exercise (planned and repetitive for improving and maintaining fitness), physical education (academic subject with planned and sequential learning)
 - goal: give every student skills to be a healthy and active individual
 - Iowa adopted SHAPE standards: guides teaching and drives lesson planning, psychomotor/cognitive/affective standard domains
 - Iowa requires 45 minutes per week
 - there has been an increase in childhood obesity, type 2 diabetes, cardiovascular disease, and prevalence of mental illness
 - ask parents, educators, and community to be proactive and get the word out of the importance of physical education and encourage involvement and funding help
 - brain break videos have been created and will be sent to Brooke Hollahan from the Wellness Committee ASAP, she will get them out to the teachers for inside recess options
