Bids will be received until 11:00 a.m., February 5, 2020, at the Business Office of the Board of Education, 1002 West First Street, Cedar Falls, Iowa 50613. Submit one copy in an envelope marked "North Cedar Playground Equipment."

The award of contract may be made by the Board of Education of the Cedar Falls Community School District to any responsible bidder or bidders offering suitable supplies, equipment and/or service at the lowest price, taking into consideration the quality of materials and/or service in the best interest of the School District. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids, or any part thereof, and to waive informalities, irregularities, or technicalities in any bid and to enter into such contract or contracts as shall be deemed in the best interests of the Cedar Falls Community School District.

- 1. Bid Form: All bids must be made upon the forms supplied by the School District. Bid forms are to be completed in fullest detail indicating full name of bidding firm, full name of manufacturing firm, manufacturer's number for item bid, and listing major deviations from specifications.
- 2. Manufacturer's names, catalog numbers, trade names, etc., are used in these specifications to indicate quality, style, and types of supplies only. Other trade names and manufacturer's items will be considered if in the opinion of the Board of Education they conform in quality and style as set forth in the specifications.
- 3. Do not include Federal or State taxes in these bids as school districts are exempt from such taxes. See Sec. 422.45, par. 5, 2001 Code. Purchaser agrees to sign standard tax exemption paper.
- 4. Shipping costs must bid <u>F.O.B. Cedar Falls, Iowa.</u> All prices must reflect the shipping or freight costs. No additional charges for shipping and handling will be accepted.
- 5. Claims: In the event any items are damaged in shipment and results in claims against the carrier, such claims must be handled entirely by the supplier. No charge backs will be accepted by the Board of Education for failure on the part of the supplier to properly handle such claims.
- 6. Error in Shipment: Errors in shipment of equipment and/or supplies in numbers, sizes, etc., must be corrected by the supplier without cost to the Board of Education.
