

The Board of Directors of the Cedar Falls Community School District in the County of Black Hawk, State of Iowa, met in regular session pursuant to the laws and rules of said Board at the City of Cedar Falls City Hall, 220 Clay Street, Cedar Falls, Iowa, at 5:30 p.m. The meeting was called to order by the President and the roll being called there were present Jeff Hassman in the chair, and the following named Directors: Nate Gruber, Dr. Allan Heisterkamp, Susie Hines, Jeff Orvis, Sasha Wohlpert and Jenny Leeper. Item No. 7 – Approve Resolution Directing the Sale of Approximately \$32,900,000 School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds Series, 2021

Director Wohlpert moved and Director Gruber seconded the motion to approve the resolution directing the sale of \$32,900,000 school infrastructure sales, services and use tax revenue bond series 2021 to Regions Capital Advantage, Inc. in association with Piper Sandler & Co. True Interest cost 2.1400%, maturity June 1, 2039 as presented. RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SALE OF APPROXIMATELY \$32,900,000 SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE SALES, SERVICES AND USE TAX REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2021

This is the time and place for the sale of School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2021 (the "Bonds");

WHEREAS, the School District has received proposals for the sale of the Bonds and has arranged for the sale of these Bonds to Regions Capital Advantage, Inc. at a purchase price of par, plus accrued interest to date of delivery:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CEDAR FALLS COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF BLACK HAWK, STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The sale of approximately \$32,900,000 School Infrastructure, Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2021, to be dated the date of delivery, for the purpose of providing funds to construct, build, furnish and equip a new high school building and to improve the site, including public infrastructure such as streets, water, sewer and stormwater, including costs of issuance and a debt service reserve fund if required by the purchaser, upon the following terms, is approved and confirmed.

Section 2. That the President and Secretary are authorized and directed to issue and deliver approximately \$32,900,000 School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, in the aggregate principal amount of approximately \$32,900,000, each in the denomination of \$100,000 or integral multiples of \$5,000 in excess thereof, bearing interest and maturing as follows:

Item No. 9 – Approval of Permanent Easement of Sanitary Sewer

Dr. Pattee reviewed the permanent easement with the City of Cedar Falls. This is a small section of land in the southwest corner of the new high school site that has been set aside for a permanent sanitary sewer and manhole. Director Gruber moved and Director Wohlpart seconded the motion Cedar Falls Community School District Board of Education approve the Permanent Sanitary Sewer Easement with the City of Cedar Falls as presented. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Gruber, Hassman, Heisterkamp, Hines, Leeper, Orvis and Wohlpart. Those voting “no” none. Motion carried.

Item No. 10 – Approval of 2021-2022 CFESP Contract

Dr. Talbot reviewed the tentative agreement that was reached between the District and the Cedar Falls Educational Support Professionals (CFESP) on April, 7, 2021. The contract is a one-year contract beginning July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022 for base wages and wages for returning employees for the Cedar Falls Educational Support Professionals (CFESP).

The base wage increase will be \$0.50 per hour for Para Educator: Special Education and Secretary I & II and \$0.40 per hour for all other classifications. The wage increase for returning employees will be \$0.50 per hour for Para Educator: Special Education and Secretary I & II and \$0.40 per hour for all other classifications. The total wage increase is 3.74% including FICA and IPERS. CFESP has ratified this agreement. After discussion, Director Heisterkamp moved and Director Orvis seconded the motion to approve the proposed 2021-2022 contract between the Cedar Falls Educational Support Professionals and the Cedar Falls Community School District as presented. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Hassman, Heisterkamp, Hines, Leeper, Orvis and Wohlpart. Those voting “no” Gruber. Motion carried.

Item No. 11 – Approval of 2021-2022 Teamsters Local 138 Base Wage Contract

Dr. Talbot reviewed the tentative agreement between the District and the Teamsters Local 138 for a one-year period July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022. This tentative agreement has been ratified by the Teamsters Local 138.

Base wage increase is \$0.50/hour for all classifications

Wage increase for all returning employees is \$0.50/hour for all classifications, with additional increase in classifications I, III, and IV of \$0.10 per hour. The total package increase in base wages, FICA, IPERS is 3.50%.

The total package settlement i.e. base wages, wages, FICA, IPERS and insurance is 3.420%. Director Hines moved and Director Leeper seconded the motion to approve the proposed 2021-2022 Teamsters Local 138 collective bargaining contract as presented. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Hassman, Heisterkamp, Hines, Leeper, Orvis, and Wohlpart. Those voting “no” Gruber. Motion carried.

Item No.12 – Superintendent’s Report
