Tuesday-Friday School Day:

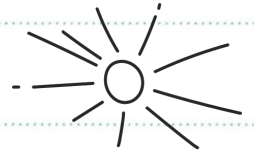

The Juniors Highs are represented by (2) parent members for each building and all parents are encouraged to attend meetings.



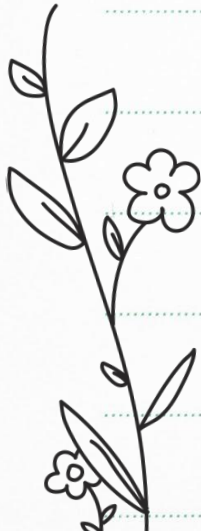
Booster membership supports athletics through Activity Pass purchases. Business and organizations join with advertising options.
