A NOTE FROM MR. BOEVERS:

We have had a busy start of the year at Peet Junior High. On Monday, we started the day with 7th graders and new 8th & 9th graders. We spent time helping those students get acclimated to the building and made sure they were able to get logged on to Chromebooks. All remaining students started at 9:30. Students went through their normal Monday schedule. Teachers met in the library following the school day yesterday, and they were energized! We are excited to have kids back in the building.

Today, we resume with a normal schedule. Students will attend all of their classes, and meet with teachers. Our Peet faculty and staff are excited to kick-off the new school year. Most people do not get to experience a feeling of starting over each year, getting to do that with kids is one of the rewards of being an educator.

SPORTS PHYSICALS/CODE OF CONDUCT:

All students who plan to participate in a sport/activity must turn-in two forms before they will be allowed to practice.

FORM #1 = Code of Conduct/Concussion Form – new form must be signed at the start of each school year

- Must be signed by the Athlete and a Parent/Guardian

FORM #2 = Sports Physical – good for 13 months

- Page 1 filled out by a parent
- Page 2 filled out and signed by a doctor
- Page 2 signed by a parent

If these steps are not followed before practice, students will need to sit-out until forms are turned-in.

SPORTS PHYSICALS/CODE OF CONDUCT forms will need to be turned in to the front office between **7:30am and 3:00pm**. We will not accept physicals after 3:00pm due to high volume traffic for the end of day dismissal. 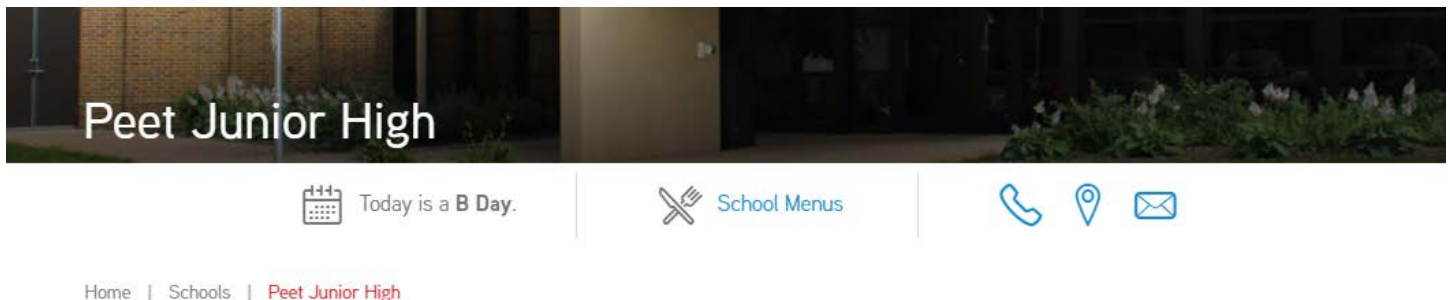
MONDAY LATE STARTS: Every Monday, classes at Peet Junior High will start at 9:30am which is 90 minutes later than the normal start time of 8:00am. Buses will pick up 90 minutes later than the Tuesday – Friday pick-up times. A chart for bus pick-up times can be found [HERE](#).

AFTER SCHOOL PICK-UP: Students that are not involved in after school activities will need to leave school grounds by 3:15. It is important that they are picked up, riding the bus or walking home by 3:15pm, because we do not have supervision for those students. If you have questions, please call Mr. Boevers.

A-B DAY CALENDAR:

Click [HERE](#) to view the A-B Day Calendar for the 2019-20 school year. You will notice November 7 & 11 will both be B days, November 15 & 18 are both B days, January 16 & 21 are both B days and March 13 & 23 will both be A days. Another change to note is in that case of a snow day, we will make up the day missed the following day. Example: February 4th is a B day and say a snow day is called on this day, when we return on February 5th, that will be a B day (not an A day that was previously scheduled). We will continue in that new rotation the remaining of the school year, unless another snow day is called. Updates to the A-B day calendar will be found on all district websites at the top (see image below on where to see if it is an A or B day).

Changes to this years A-B day schedule have been made to keep all buildings aligned with the elementary rotations. If you have questions, please contact Mr. Boevers.



ACTIVITY BUS:

Students who travel to Holmes for after school activities/athletics will ride **bus #20**, activity bus. 9th graders who go to the high school for after school activities/athletics will ride **bus #16**. These bus' will leave immediately after school.

BUSING INFORMATION:

Bus routes have been published at <http://www.cfschools.org/parents/transportation>. All students who live over **two** miles away from Peet are eligible for a free pass. Students who live less than two miles away and wish to ride the bus will need to purchase monthly tickets; students will ride free the month of August. Bus prices are as follows: two-way monthly pass - \$50.00 / one-way (AM or PM) monthly pass - \$25.00. **All bus tickets for September must be purchased by September 7.** Thereafter, tickets are to be purchased during the week preceding the first of each month. **Bus riders must show their pass or ticket each day when getting on the bus.** Additionally, the District is offering one-day, one-way bus passes that are sold for \$1.25. These bus passes will be sold in the main office at Peet starting on August 29.

CHROMEBOOK INFORMATION:

Students are charged for Chromebook repair parts based on the model and the cost of the part to the district. Every year, prices fluctuate, and Chromebooks and their replacement parts are not immune to that. Many parts cost less than last year, a few are holding steady, and others have increased. The following chart lists the current fees that will be charged for each part during the 2019-2020 school year, which equals our cost.

Note that the total replacement fee is calculated according to the model and age of the Chromebook. We use the original purchase price from which is deducted one third of the cost for each year of age of the Chromebook, and includes the OS management fee assigned to that CB. Please remind your student to handle their Chromebook with care!
