

NEW CFHS FACILITY: One Team, One Dream



QUICK FACTS

The new high school and adjacent football stadium are being built and paid for through the bond. The money raised through this campaign is for connected complimentary spaces, specifically the new aquatic center and Tiger Performance Center (TPC).

Securing pledges now will allow the district to save money by taking advantage of the cranes and other construction equipment already currently in place on site. Building these facilities after completion of the high school will cost significantly more due to rising construction costs and bringing large construction equipment back to the site.

Cedar Falls spends ~\$50,000 per year renting outside facilities for activities and athletics.

Current pool facilities were constructed in 1977 and have reached the end of their lifespan. They will be remodeled into much-needed junior high classroom space. Maintenance on one, modern pool, will be less than two archaic pools.

The TPC will be a multi-purpose space that includes field turf, running track, and multi-purpose flooring. It will provide an indoor space for PE, student clubs, organizations, robotics, marching band and other fine arts, student experiments and other activities.

The new competition pool (10 lanes, 25 yards by 25 meters) and recreation pool (4 lanes, 25 yards) will allow for competition, teaching and therapeutic use in the same facility. The new aquatic center will be open for the public throughout the school day.

COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC IMPACT

Both facilities will allow the district to host events and tournaments that will increase local business revenue, help booster clubs grow revenue, and allow our youth and secondary programs to save on travel.

The community businesses will earn an additional \$950k per year for 50 years which is \$50 million over the life of the pool.
