Policy Title: Students as Carriers of Communications Code No. 1001.3

The Board of Education recognizes that effective communications are frequently a part of worthwhile civic and

community projects. However, occasionally the type of project or the frequency of requests may interfere with the

effective and efficient use of school time.

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to prohibit the use of students as carriers of commercial and/or non-

school messages, except in those cases judged by the superintendent of schools or designee as directly related to the

educational tasks of the school system. This policy is in coordination with policy 1005.1, Teacher and Student

Involvement in Sales, Money-Raising and Charitable Activities.
