

Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress
– formally known as: Iowa Assessments or ITBS

Peet Junior High School will be ISASP testing 7th, 8th and 9th grade students in reading on Tuesday, April 1st, math on Wednesday, April 2nd, language and a writing essay on Thursday, April 3 & 8th grade Science on Friday, April 4.

As always, this is a very important time to have students in school.

If you have plans or appointments that conflict with these days, we would appreciate your work to protect these days so your student can be in school.

On Tuesday, April 1 and Wednesday, April 2, students arrive at the normal time with testing beginning at 8:10 a.m. All students will complete testing at 9:20am and we will run a Monday class schedule.

On Thursday, April 3, students arrive at the normal time with testing beginning at 8:10 a.m. All students will complete testing at 9:50am and we will run the following class schedule:

10:00-10:32: Period 1 10:36-11:08: Period 2 11:12-11:46: Period 3 *no Tiger Time *Monday PM schedule 11:50-1:14: Period 4 1:18-1:49: Period 5 1:53-2:24: Period 6 2:28-3:00: Period 7

On Friday, April 4, 8th grade students will be taking the Science test during their Science classes.

To ensure that all students have the proper amount of time to complete the tests, periods 6 and 7 will test earlier in the day and not during their scheduled science class period.

- 8th Grade Students with Science Class during period 7 will miss their period 3 class and report to the back gym for testing. During period 7, they will report to their science class for a study hall.
- Students with Science Class during period 6 will miss their period 5 class and report to the back gym for testing. During period 6, they will report to their science class for a study hall.

Attached below is a copy of the Test Preparation Presentation all students will be presented on Monday, March 24 and Monday, March 31. Feel free to review with your student at home in preparation for testing.

We will also hold an all school assembly on March 26 stressing the importance for students to be in attendance and on-time each day from April 1-4, do their best, come to school fully prepared with a charged Chromebook and breakfast eaten.

This year will be the fifth year of state wide assessments through the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) – formally known as: Iowa Assessments or ITBS. The testing will all be done on student Chromebooks.

ACTIVITY BUS

Students who travel to Holmes or CFHS for after school activities /athletics will ride bus #20, activity bus. This bus will leave immediately after school.

BOUND

All 7-12 grade athletes will be required to sign-up for their activities using the Bound program. Register your student-athlete online then click on registration.

Bound is a web platform used by all high schools and most junior high schools in Iowa to house team schedules, state required stats, event locations, event tickets (and passes), and much more. Cedar Falls will be using many more Bound features starting this school year.

- 1. Register for <u>Bound</u> and use mobile apps.
- 2. Purchase digital <u>student activity</u> <u>pass</u>.
- 3. Purchase <u>individual event tickets</u>. (HS events only)
- 4. Register your student-athlete online.

ISASP CONTINUED:

All tests will be untimed, so any student who needs more time to finish each test will be allowed to do so. You will also not need to bring a calculator as that will be available on the Chromebook. Teachers have and will continue to prepare students for these tests, as we are doing our best to set all students up for success.

On these test days, student will need to bring:

- Chromebooks FULLY charged! All testing will be done on the student Chromebook, so make sure it is charged the night before.
- A book to read if finished early from testing. No phones, watches, or electronics of any kind will be allowed during the testing time, and students will not be allowed to be on Chromebooks when not testing.
- Each students best effort! These tests are important for future success and to help us schedule students in the correct classes for next year. Don't be nervous, just do your best!

Key Points from:

Keep Your Child On Track in Middle and High School: Pay Attention to Attendance

Even as children grow older and more independent, families play a key role in making sure students access learning opportunities and understand why attendance is so important for success in school and on the job.

Did you know?

- Students should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful and on track to graduation
- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school
- By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores

What You Can Do

- Talk about the importance of showing up to school every day
- Try not to schedule dental and medical appointments during the school day
- Help your teen stay engaged by encouraging them to join meaningful after-school activities, including sports and clubs
- Check on your child's attendance to be sure absences are not adding up
- Seek help from school staff, other parents or community agencies if you need support
