III. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT – Kim Cross (5 min)

- a. Kindergarten numbers are coming in and we have over 60 students for next year, increase numbers by 10. 25-30 virtual kids coming back to school and a list of 15 new kids. They are working on enrollment and class lists for next year. Registration link will be sent to returning students and families in July. Planning for end of the year activities. Field day, awards ceremony with 6th graders (able to social distance in the gym for the grade level to be together). The school will not be giving out attendance awards this year due to quarantines and COVID restrictions. Most District staff vaccinated, unable to know exact numbers due to privacy.
