Report cards will be emailed to families on Tuesday, October 25. Please limit conference time to not more than seven minutes with each teacher.

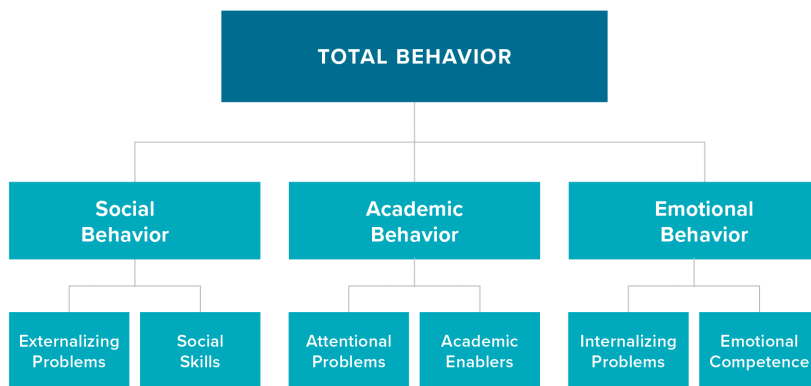

We know that good data to support our instruction is just as important as good instruction! In alignment with our district framework for Social Emotional Learning, our district will be using SAEBSRS (Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Risk Screener), a universal screening tool through Fastbridge (FAST screeners currently for reading and math). It includes a teacher rating scale for grades K-12, where our teachers will rate the same students three times a year on three big areas of behaviors: academic behaviors, social behaviors, emotional behaviors that might serve as barriers to learning. Data will lead us to better interventions that meet needs with immediacy.
