Item No. 6- Approval of the 2018-2019 School Year Budget Amendment and Set Public Hearing

Mrs. Gonnerman reviewed the proposed expenditure amendment to the 2018-2019 school year for instructional programs from \$44,433,887 to \$45,104,706. This increase is for expenditures due to instructional start-up costs for Aldrich Elementary. An increase in support services from \$17,872,961 to \$18,906,284 for Aldrich Elementary start-up, transportation, and utility costs. An increase in Non-instructional programs of \$2,747,660 to \$2,833,809 for Aldrich Elementary food service start-up costs and an increase in other expenditures from \$20,255,841 to \$25,386,366 due to the shift in North Cedar and Orchard Hill project timeline to fiscal year 2019. The amendment to the 2018-2019 school year budget will not raise property taxes, but will give the District the legal authority to spend the additional dollars necessary for the additional expenses. After discussion, Director Hassman moved and Director Leeper seconded the motion that the Cedar Falls Board of Education set 5:30 p.m. Monday, April 8, 2019 at the City of Cedar Falls City Hall, 220 Clay Street, Cedar Falls Iowa 50613 as the time, date, and place to hold a public hearing to amend the current 2018-2019 school year estimated budget expenditures.
