If there is a snow day, we will make up the day we missed the following day. Example: If there is a snow day on Monday, December 5, a scheduled A day, when we return to school on Tuesday, December 6, that will be an A day.

If there is a weather related delay, we will run a Monday school day schedule, with classes starting at 9:30am (90-minutes late).

# IOWA SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PROFILE

The Iowa School Performance Profiles have been released. The profile rates and compares how all Iowa public schools have performed in 9 different categories. Most of the categories are tied to Iowa Assessment scores. Our Peet students performed very well, and Peet was classified as "High Performing". If you click on the link above and type in Peet, you can see our detailed results. Peet was above state average in all 9 categories, and well above the average in some of the categories. I am very proud of how our students performed. I know that their success is a direct result of the work all students and staff do on a daily basis. I also know that student success can be attributed in part to the support they get at home from parents and guardians. I feel fortunate for the support our students and teachers get at home. Thanks for that!!!

One of the categories in the profile that I am most proud of is the "Conditions for Learning" category which is a measure of school climate for students. A high score indicates a positive perception of the school environment. If you click on that link, you can see a breakdown of how our students perceive the school's climate. There is detailed information based on how certain subgroups answered such as Low SES, students with disabilities, and race. We were above state average in all those categories as well. Every student and adult in the building impacts this score and I want to thank everybody for playing their part.
