Item No. 7 – Set Public Hearing Date for Phase II of Cedar Falls CSD Natatorium

President Stutzman introduced Tim Turnis of Invision Architecture. Mr. Tunis reviewed the natatorium project. Director Meyer moved and Director Witt seconded the motion the Cedar Falls CSD Board of Education set a public hearing date of June 10, 2024 at the City of Cedar Falls City Hall, 220 Clay Street, Cedar Falls, Iowa, at 5:30 p.m. for the High School natatorium project. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Gruber, Leeper, Meyer, Orvis, Peterson, Witt, and Stutzman. Those voting “no” none. Motion carried.

Item No. 8 – Approval of Issuance of Contracts from May 14, 2024 to June 10, 2024

Director Peterson moved and Director Gruber seconded the motion the Cedar Falls CSD Board of Education grant the Superintendent, or designee the authority, or designee the authority to accept resignations for the 2023-2024 school year and to issue contracts of employment for the 2024-25 school year, to licensed teachers and licensed coaches, subject to job candidates fulfilling all usual and customary post offer pre-employment requirements as required by District policy. Such authority shall be in effect for the period May 14, 2024 to June 10, 2024. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Gruber, Leeper, Meyer, Orvis, Peterson, Witt, and Stutzman. Those voting “no” none. Motion carried.

Item No. 9 – Approval of 2024-2026 CFESP Contract

Dr. Talbot reviewed the tentative agreement that was reached between the District and the Cedar Falls Educational Support Professionals (CFESP) on May 7, 2024. The contract is a two-year contract beginning July 1, 2024-June 30, 2026 for base wages and wages for returning employees for the Cedar Falls Educational Support Professionals (CFESP). This agreement has been ratified by the Cedar Falls Education Support Professionals.

For year one 2024-2025 the base wage increase will be for the following classifications and all returning employees: Regular program and Paraeducator II – Media \$0.60, Secretary I and II \$0.70, and Special Education and Secretary III \$0.80 for 2024-25. For year two 2025-2026 base wage increase will be \$0.60 per hour for all classifications and returning employees.

Insurance is an excluded subject of bargaining. Employee contributions toward the single insurance premium will increase by \$10.00 a month from \$85.00 to \$95.00 per month in year one. Insurance premium changes if any for year two (2025-2026) will be determined when information is provided by ISEBA in the first quarter of 2025.

Total package settlement including wages, FICA, IPERS and insurance is averaged over two years is 3.08%. After discussion, Director Gruber moved and Director Peterson seconded the motion to approve the proposed 2024-2026 contract between the Cedar Falls Educational Support Professionals (CFESP) and the Cedar Falls Community School District as presented. Directors voting in favor of the motion: Gruber, Leeper, Meyer, Orvis, Peterson, Witt, and Stutzman. Those voting “no” none. Motion carried.

Director Gruber inquired about the change in last day of school. Dr. Pattee reported inclement weather days and required student contact hours are factors on determining the last day of student enrollment.

Director Meyer inquired on the completion of the natatorium. Dr. Pattee reported intent is to have it done by next spring and have water in the pool by April of 2025.

Item No. 12 – Closed Session of the Board of Education Under Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(j)

Director Orvis moved and Director Peterson seconded the motion that the Cedar Falls Board of Education enter into closed session to discuss the purchase or sale of particular real estate only where premature disclosure could be reasonably expected to increase the price the governmental body would have to pay for that property or reduce the price the governmental body would receive for that property.
