

Cedar Falls High School – Fall Sports COVID-19 Fan Guidelines

General Conference Guidelines

The Mississippi Valley Conference (MVC), based upon guidance received from the Governor's Office of the State of Iowa, the Iowa Department of Education, the Iowa Department of Public Health, the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union, and the Iowa High School Athletic Association, has released its procedures for spectator admission to the MVC member school fall sports seasons.

Admission: Normal admission will be charged at each venue. Exact change preferred. Some venues may have touchless payment options.

Attendance: Attendance and capacity limitations are determined by each MVC school for each sport, venue and/or event. Please refer to the 2020 Fall Spectator COVID-19 Guidelines for each school available on the conference website www.mississippivalleyiowa.org. Please note that schools will be finalizing plans over the next few days and uploading them to the conference website. Due to the nature of this pandemic they could change, please check back frequently.

Personal Protective Equipment:

- Masks are required at all MVC venues for all events for fall sports: Football, Swim, Volleyball, Cross Country, and Golf.
- Spectators are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer

Spectators are Asked to:

- Accept personal responsibility for following public health guidelines
- Practice safe social distancing (limit group to single households).
- Be patient and use common sense
- Abide by posted signage
- Stay home if you show signs or symptoms or if you have been in contact with someone with a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- Spectators not following guidelines may be asked to leave

Football Specific Guidelines

- To provide for social distancing, spectators will be limited to 30% capacity or 5000 spectators in the UNI-Dome.
- Seating will be limited to every 3rd row starting at row 3.
- Family members living in the same household may sit together in pods of 10 or less. The UNI-Dome has asked that we do this in rows.
- 4 seats should separate individuals and groups on each side for social distancing. This is a requirement put in place by the University of Northern Iowa
- All spectators are required to wear a mask for admission and throughout the duration of the contest. If seated in your group, mask may be removed to eat and drink.

- Social distancing practices will be expected at all times while in the UNI-Dome.
- In the student section, students will be asked to keep 2 seats open in between each student in every third designated row. **Students must wear mask entire time they are in the student section.**
- Cheerleaders will be in the north end zone area to cheer during the game.
- Dance team will be in the south end zone area during the game.
- Elementary students will be allowed in with a family member or guardian only. Student must stay with or be escorted by the guardian at all times.
- Patrons are asked to have exact change (\$6 adults, \$5 children) when purchasing tickets.
- All coaches and non-playing members on the sideline need to wear a mask.
- It is recommended that all players wear their mask when not competing on the field.
- Personnel in press box need to have a mask unless they are talking. Radio announcers need to sit 6' apart.
- Tailgating will not be allowed on the University of Northern Iowa campus.
- Visiting teams should use social distancing guidelines while using the locker room.
- Fans are not allowed on the field unless they are part of a specific organized recognition.

Volleyball Specific Guidelines

- All spectators are required to wear a mask for admission and throughout the duration of the contest. Mask may be removed to eat and drink if social distancing requirements are met.
- Family members may sit in groups/pods of up to 10 people. There should be 6' separating each group/pod.
- Coaches should wear masks as much as possible.
- It is suggested that participants wear masks anytime they are not on the actual playing floor.
- Students are asked to sit in designated student section seats which will be marked for proper social distancing. Masks must be worn the entire time.

Swimming Specific Guidelines

- All spectators are required to wear a mask for admission and throughout the duration of the contest. Mask may be removed to eat and drink if social distancing requirements are met.
- It is suggested that participants wear masks anytime they are not in the pool.
- Family members may sit in groups/pods of up to 10 people. There should be 6' separating each group/pod.

Golf Specific Guidelines

- Masks should be worn around club houses and anytime social distancing of 6' cannot be maintained.
- Masks should be worn by players while on putting green and driving range.
- Course specific guidelines should be shared by coaches and followed.

Cross Country Specific Guidelines

- Masks should be worn around courses and anytime social distancing of 6' cannot be maintained.
- Guidelines provided by each venue should be shared by coaches and followed.
