<u>COUNSELING SOUND-BYTE</u>: Pay Attention to Attendance - Keep Your Child On Track in Junior High and High School Showing up for school has a huge impact on a student's academic success starting in kindergarten and continuing through high school. Even as children grow older and more independent, families play a key role in making sure students get to school safely every day and understand why attendance is so important for success in school and on the job.

#### DID YOU KNOW?

- Students should miss NO more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful and on track to graduation.
- Absences can be a sign that a student is losing interest in school, struggling with school work, dealing with a bully
  or facing some other potentially serious difficulty.
- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of the three signs that a student may drop out of high school.
- By 9th grade, regular and high attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores.
- Missing 10 percent, or about 18 days, of the school year can drastically affect a student's academic success.
- Students can be chronically absent even if they only miss a day or two every few weeks.
- Attendance is an important life skill that will help your child graduate from college and keep a job.

#### WHAT CAN YOU DO?

### Make school attendance a priority

- Talk about the importance of showing up to school everyday, make that the exception.
- Help your child maintain daily routines, such as finishing homework and getting a good night's sleep.
- Try not to schedule dental and medical appts. during the school day.
- Don't let your child stay home unless truly sick. Complaints of headaches or stomach aches may be signs of anxiety.

## Help your teen stay engaged

- Find out if your child feels engaged by his classes and feels safe from bullies and other threats. Make sure he/she
  is not missing class because of behavioral issues and school discipline policies. If any of these are problems, work
  with your school.
- Stay on top of your child's social contacts. Peer pressure can lead to skipping school, while students without many friends can feel isolated.
- Encourage meaningful afterschool activities, including sports and clubs.

#### Communicate with the school

- Know the school's attendance policy incentives and penalties
- Talk to teachers if you notice sudden changes in behavior. These could be tied to something going on at school.
- Check on your child's attendance to be sure absences are not piling up.

<u>SCHEDULING:</u> In January, Peet Counselors will be visiting all grade levels to discuss scheduling options and registration for the 2018 – 2019 school year. Please refer to the scheduling dates below to see when the counselors will be in your student's classroom. For a schedule to be complete, each student needs to have a parent or guardian signature.

If you are a parent of an incoming 7th grader, you will receive a letter in the middle of January with a green registration sheet and information about Peet courses. Peet counselors will be visiting each elementary classroom to discuss with students scheduling for 7th grade. The dates are as follows:

Below, we have included CFHS graduation requirements for core classes and credits. A credit is earned by receiving a passing grade in a class. Passing a one semester course would be equivalent to one credit, a year long course is two credits, and an alternating day class for the whole year is one credit.
