AFTER SCHOOL-ALT/LEARNING LABS

At Peet, we put an emphasis on academics with our students. Similar to what we have done in the past, prior to Covid, we will be assigning students 30 minutes Alternative Learning Time after school if they have not completed assigned work. Students would be expected to stay in the classroom of the assigning teacher from 3:00 - 3:30 to get help from the teacher to complete the work. If that teacher is not available after school, we will assign them to another room with another teacher.

Teachers will notify parents if their student is assigned. Parents will be responsible to pick the student up at 3:30, or the students can stay for ECHOES which runs until 4:30 Tuesday - Thursday. Busing is provided for students that choose to stay for ECHOES.

If a student is involved in athletics, they will be sent to practice at 3:30.

Our intention is to teach students responsibility and the importance of completing assigned tasks on time, as well as helping them learn what they need to be successful. In the past, parents have been very supportive of this intervention to help their students. For the 2022-2023 school year, fees for first time damages to student devices will be waived. Any subsequent device damages by students after their one time waiver has been used will be assessed at the current cost of replacement parts or devices to the district. In some cases excessive damages necessitating a complete replacement of the device, intentional damage and lost devices may not be covered by the one time waiver.

Current replacement part fees are listed in the chart below. Please note that if your student has a Dell 3180 model, it is scheduled to be replaced this fall. Total replacement cost for the Dell 3100 Chromebook for the upcoming school year will be \$236 based on the district's cost.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Key Points from:

Keep Your Child On Track in Middle and High School: Pay Attention to Attendance

Even as children grow older and more independent, families play a key role in making sure students access learning opportunities and understand why attendance is so important for success in school and on the job.

Did you know?

- Students should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful and on track to graduation
- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school
- By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores

What You Can Do

- Talk about the importance of showing up to school every day
- Try not to schedule dental and medical appointments during the school day
- Help your teen stay engaged by encouraging them to join meaningful after-school activities, including sports and clubs
- Check on your child's attendance to be sure absences are not adding up
- Seek help from school staff, other parents or community agencies if you need support
